What is *Teach One to Lead One*[®]?



The *Teach One to Lead One*[®] program (T1L1) focuses on building character and leadership in young people through powerful training, practical materials, exciting presentations and hands-on activities. The T1L1 program has been praised by government officials for being one of the best programs they've seen for combining mentorship with a solid curriculum. Specifically targeting students in the public school system and juvenile courts (ages 12-18), the T1L1 philosophy introduces universal ethical principles. Along with these principles, students are equipped with proven life skills and healthy habits, transforming them into responsible citizens.

What makes *Teach One to Lead One*[®] unique?

- The program is specifically designed for high school- and middle school-age youth (most character and leadership education programs target elementary age students).
- This program teaches young people about universal ethical principles and practical leadership skills in order to help them make important decisions that will impact them for the rest of their lives.
- Character and leadership cannot be taught outside of positive relationships between young people and adult role models. The program delivery is relationship- and mentor-based.
- Local leaders act as mentors for the kids to demonstrate that the community is committed to their future.
- The program is based on principles that govern human life that apply to all people, in all places, at all times.
- Storytelling is used as an effective tool to convey the importance of living by principles.
- Guest speakers present their point of view to help students learn from other people's experiences.
- A Celebrate Life International-trained individual, known as a *Youth Development Professional* (YDP[™]) is present in the classroom for each activity to ensure the quality of the program.*
- Through small group discussions, the program encourages students to share their struggles and look for positive solutions.
- The program is revised annually and updated with materials that reflect current issues that high school and middle school kids commonly face.
- Program graduates have a positive influence among their peers.
